LEAF at Work, a one-hour workshop for high school students, provides students with tools, resources, and information to help them make informed decisions about their legal rights in the workplace. Students work with trained facilitators to critically analyze real-life scenarios that young people may encounter at work. Sessions address equality issues in the workplace, including sexual harassment, pay equity, and discrimination.
