LEAF @ Work



This workshop helps young people identify sex discrimination and equality rights in the workplace. It includes introductions to human rights codes as well as section 15 of the *Charter*. Suggested for **grades 9–12**, and newcomers.

Only Yes Means Yes



This workshop introduces youth to the law of consent and sexual assault in Canada. The workshop touches on legal issues concerning consent and fraud; sexual assault; publication of intimate images. Suggested for **grades 9–12**.

Double Tap on Consent



This workshop helps explain the legal issues around technology-facilitated gender-based violence. It looks at gender-based violence on the internet through issues of consent, sexting, sending intimate images, online harassment, voyeurism etc. Suggested for **grades 9–12**.

Reproductive Justice



This workshop introduces youth to the legal issues around reproductive care in Canada. It includes sources of reproductive rights in Canadian law and the gaps in access for reproductive care. Suggested for **grades 11–12**.
